The Rabbinical Search Committee has chosen **Rabbi Dov Greer and Rabbi Ashie Schreier** as the two finalists for the candidate for Rabbi.


Rabbi Schreier studied at the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary (REITS) at Yeshiva University, where he received his semicha. For two years, he has been a Rabbinic Intern at Kehillas Bais Yehudah, in Wesley Hills, NY.

Rabbi Greer studied at the Jerusalem Kollel where he received semicha from the Rosh Kollel Rabbi Yitzchok Berkowitz. He also received semicha from Rabbi Zalman Nechemia Goldberg of the Jerusalem Religious Civil Court. He is presently the Interim Rabbi at Eitz Chaim of Dogwood Park in West Hempstead, NY. He also teaches at the Philadelphia Community Kollel in Bala Cynwyd, PA and is a trained Mohel servicing the Tri-State area and beyond.

Voting by members on the eligible voter list will be done in the shul office and will continue Monday May 22 from 9:00am to 5:00pm and from 8:00pm to 10:00pm, and Tuesday May 23 from 9:00am to 5:00pm.
