On 5/31/17, at approximately 1621 hours, Officers Tilley, Fiscella, and I were dispatched to 765 Elm Street, for a report of a suspicious person.

Upon my arrival, I spoke with Mico Burgos (D.O.B. 7/21/67) who contacted Police. Burgos stated that today at approximately 1535 hours, he encountered a male which he described as, a white male, approximately forty years of age, medium build, with salt and pepper hair, come to the Yeshiva of New Haven School.

Burgos stated that this male stated that he was attempting to locate his four year old daughter and is unable to use his phone today due to an observed holiday. This male stated that his GPS system led him to this address. This male then entered the school walked around then ran out of the rear door.

Burgos stated that this male entered a white Jeep Grand Cherokee bearing Connecticut registration, AC18532 and circled the block numerous times. Burgos stated that this male was acting in an extremely suspicious manner and alarmed several members of the school.

I entered said registration into COLLECT which returned the following registered owner information: Michael A. Reichentahl (D.O.B. 5/23/74) of 97 Dickinson Dr. Shelton, CT.

Reichentahl has no prior contact history with the NHPD (confirmed through OPCenter,RMS).

I contacted the Shelton Police Department and requested that an officer attempt to make contact with Reichentahl and have him contact me regarding this incident however, negative results surfaced.

I advised Burgos to contact police immediately if he observes this male or vehicle again in said area.

No further action taken at this time.
