DECLARATION OF DEBORAH BROADLEY

I, Deborah Broadley, do declare (certify, verify, or state) under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct and is based upon my personal knowledge:

1. I am over the age of eighteen and believe in the obligations of an oath.
2. I currently work for the Connecticut Department of Correction ("DOC") as an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse ("APRN") and a Doctor of Nursing Practice ("DNP"). I hold a Doctorate in evidence-based medicine, and I am Board Certified in Family Medicine. I have been a licensed APRN for 13 years and a licensed DNP for 9 years.
3. I am currently assigned to the Cheshire Correctional Institution ("Cheshire") located in Cheshire, Connecticut.
4. As an APRN and DNP at Cheshire, my duties and responsibilities include evaluating and treating patients for acute and chronic medical conditions, preventative treatment, and urgent/emergent issues. These duties include, but are not limited to, ordering and interpreting laboratory tests, radiology imaging tests, and prescribing medications.
5. I am familiar with inmate Daniel Greer, inmate number 433222, as he is currently an inmate at Cheshire, and I have spoken with him on or about February 25, 2020. On


this occasion, I saw him in order to ask him to re-consider his refusal to go to a urology appointment at UCONN. He still declined to go to the appointment.

6. At the request of the Attorney General's Office, I have reviewed Mr. Greer's medical records, including his medical history, current medical needs, and current medications.
7. Based on my review, Mr. Greer has several current medical conditions and issues, however these are all chronic and stable conditions, which Mr. Greer is receiving medical treatment for, including medication and medical monitoring.
8. Mr. Greer had his bloodwork done most recently on December 5, 2019, and nothing in the results from this bloodwork indicates that Mr. Greer is suffering from any nutritional deficiencies.
9. Based on my knowledge of Mr. Greer's medical status, including my review of his medical records, Mr. Greer is not presently facing any imminent or life-threatening medical conditions.
10. Mr. Greer will continue to receive medical treatment and monitoring for his current medical conditions, and Mr. Greer has access to medical staff at Cheshire at any time if his medical needs, conditions, or status changes.
11. Mr. Greer is familiar with how he can access medical treatment at Cheshire, and he most recently accessed medical care at Cheshire on March 3, 2020 for a nurse-patient encounter. Mr. Greer is also seen at least daily by nursing staff when he receives his medications.
