ORDER

The following order is entered in the above matter:

ORDER:

A sanctions hearing was held on 10/1/25 regarding the filings made by the Stillman Law Firm in collections cases in the Stamford Superior Court. Testimony from attorneys involved in the processing of cases filed in Stamford Superior Court was heard and exhibits were offered into evidence. The Court enters the following orders:

- 1) The Stillman Law Firm shall file by 10/31/25 a Status Report in this case regarding the efforts the firm has undertaken since the hearing to ensure that no Return Date is ever modified again after service of the Summons and that the Summons served on a defendant is the same Summons filed in Court with no modifications;
- 2) The Stillman Law Firm shall also address in that Status Report what efforts the firm is taking regarding Practice Book § 17-23 filings where the certification in the § 17-23 is a date later than the military affidavit and/or affidavit allegedly included in the mailing to the defendant. The Stillman Law Firm is ordered to immediately correct any filing, by withdrawing the filing, where a certification of mailing is dated earlier than military affidavit or other affidavit that was allegedly included in the mailing. This issue is referred to the Statewide Grievance Panel for further review;
- 3) The Stillman Law Firm shall also address in the Status Report what efforts the firm is taking to ensure that the notarization of any affidavit filed with this Court, including military affidavits, is not later or earlier than affiant's signature and confirmation that the affiant has appeared before the notary;
- 4) The Stillman Law Firm shall also address what efforts it has undertaken to ensure that the Connecticut attorneys signing the summons are also involved in the selection of the Return Date and that no attorney signs the Summons without a Return Date;
- 5) The Stillman Law Firm shall also address what efforts it has undertaken to ensure that a non-attorney shall not file any casflow request and/or any pleading in Stamford Superior Court.

No sanctions shall enter against the Stillman Law Firm at this time. However, if the Stillman Law Firm continues to engage in the above referenced conduct a further sanctions hearing will be scheduled.
